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## The Unit Leader's Role

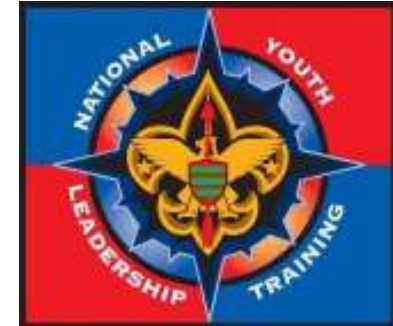
The Unit Leader's role is critical to the success of the youth Scout leader in implementing his goals. The Unit Leader must approve the scout's application.

## How is the course set up?

The patrol method is used extensively throughout the training. Patrols are on their own to set up campsites, cook meals and carry out other activities without direct adult supervision. A Troop Guide is assigned to each patrol to advise and be a resource to the participants throughout the learning process. The troop setting provides an opportunity for Scouts to practice the newly learned skills providing the home troop with improved effectiveness and enthusiasm from the youth leaders. Troop instructors will help guide this learning. The training guidelines and rules are the same for those found in the Scout Oath and Law, the Outdoor Code, and other national and council practices and procedures.

## What is NATIONAL YOUTH LEADERSHIP TRAINING?

NYLT is a week- long outdoor experience for current and future troop and crew leaders, utilizing the patrol method. It presents leadership skills in multiple formats providing the opportunity

for participants to live and practice these leadership skills. Virtually all of the training is conducted by the youth staff. The course follows the National BSA *National Youth Leadership Training* Curriculum.

Course runs both week-ends, Friday afternoon thru Sunday afternoon.



## Why should I attend? (for Scouts)

- ◆ You'll have fun.
- ◆ The leadership skills we teach will help you within scouting, in school and later in life.
- ◆ Your regular troop job will become more fun.

## Who can attend?

NYLT is for you if you're a **Boy Scout** who can answer **YES** to **All** of the following:

- ◆ You'll be 13 years old by April 8, 2010;
- ◆ You will not be 18 years old before April 25, 2010;
- ◆ You'll be at least a first class Scout by April 8, 2010;
- ◆ You now hold or intend to hold a unit leadership position;
- ◆ **You are mature enough and responsible enough to spend 2 weekends camping with boys you've never met, with minimal adult supervision, and always live the Scout oath and law;**
- ◆ You agree to practice the skills you learn at NYLT when you return to your home troop; AND
- ◆ Your parents and Unit Leader agree and recommend you.

NYLT is for you if you're a **Venture Scout** who can answer **YES** to **All** of the following:

- ◆ You are at least 14 years old
- ◆ You will not be 18 years old before April 25, 2010
- ◆ You have completed either crew officer training or Venturing Leadership Skills Course
- ◆ **You are mature enough and responsible enough to spend 2 weekends camping with boys you've never met, with minimal adult supervision, and always live the Scout oath and law;**
- ◆ You agree to practice the skills you learn at NYLT when you return to your home unit; AND
- ◆ Your parents and Unit Leader agree and recommend you.
